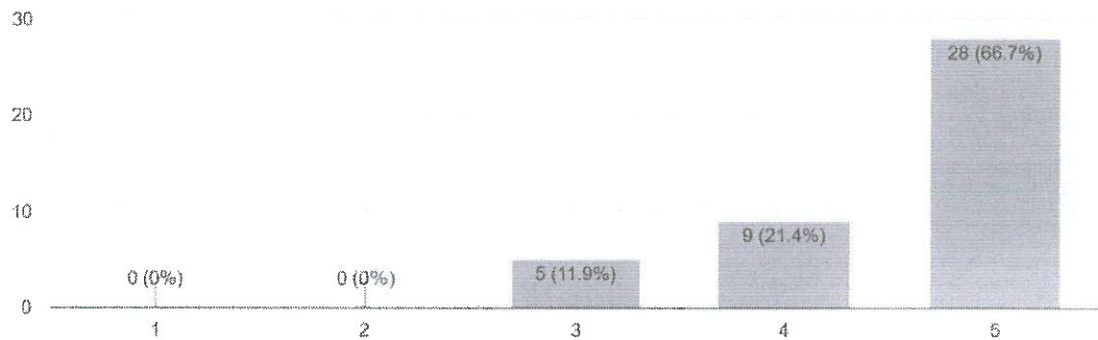

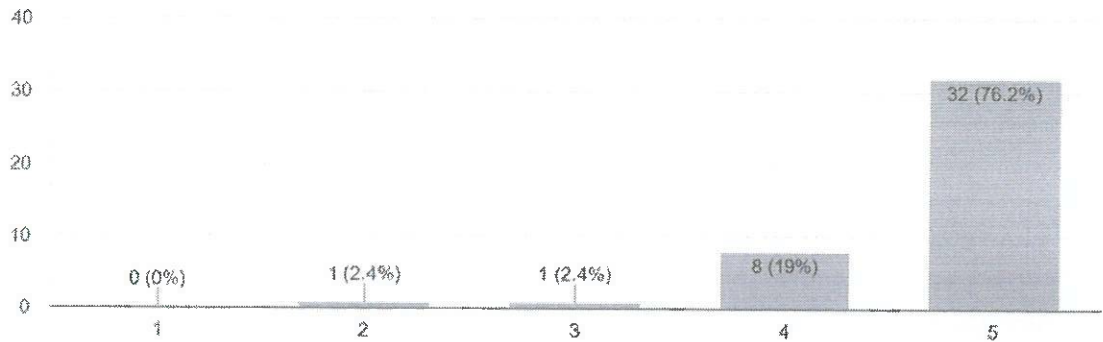

The objectives of the syllabus are well defined:

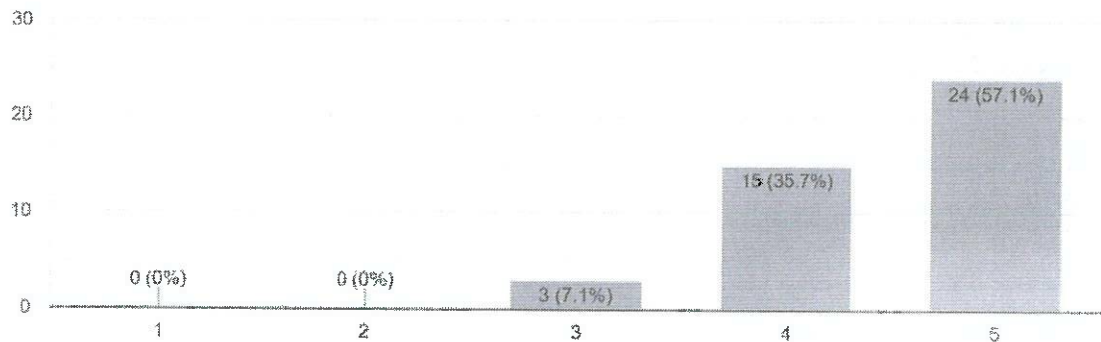

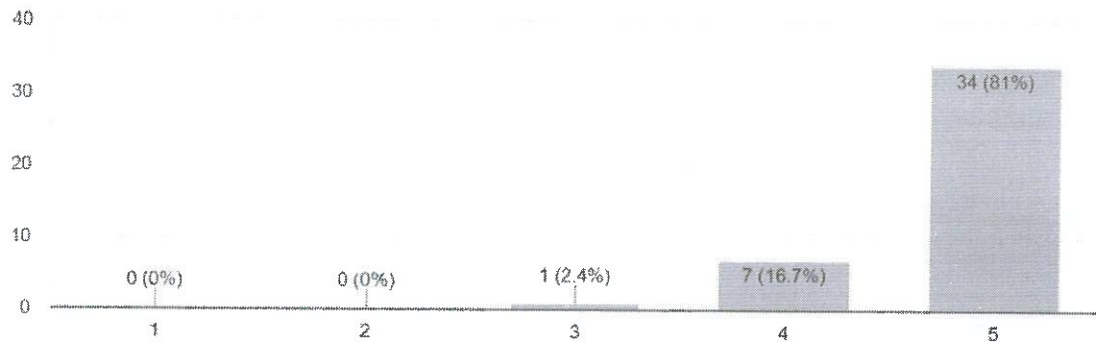

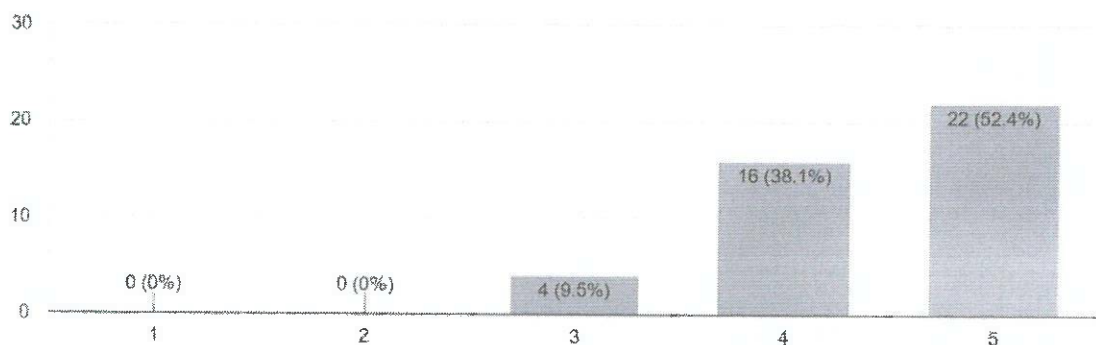

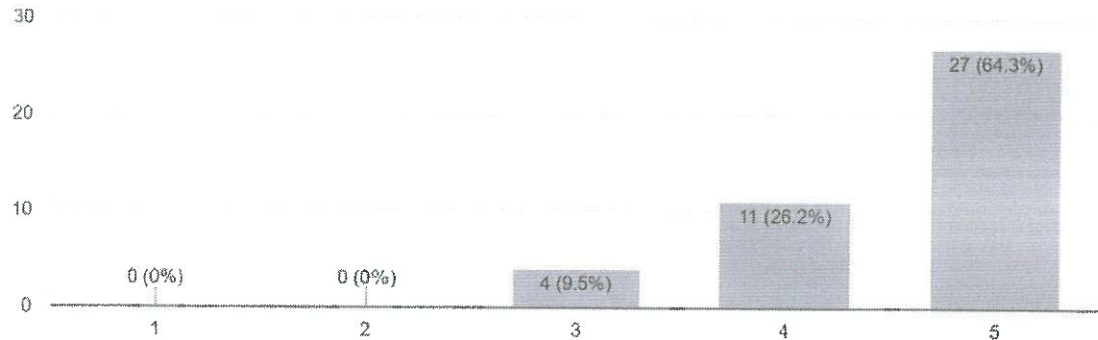

The curriculum is as per the need of students.

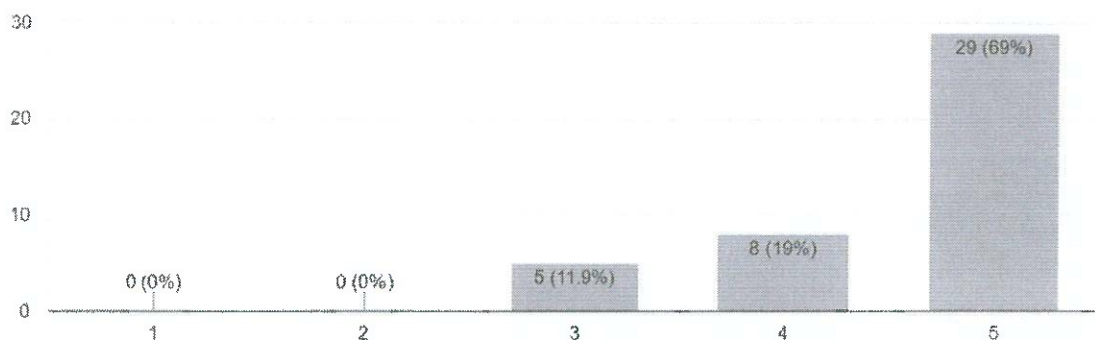

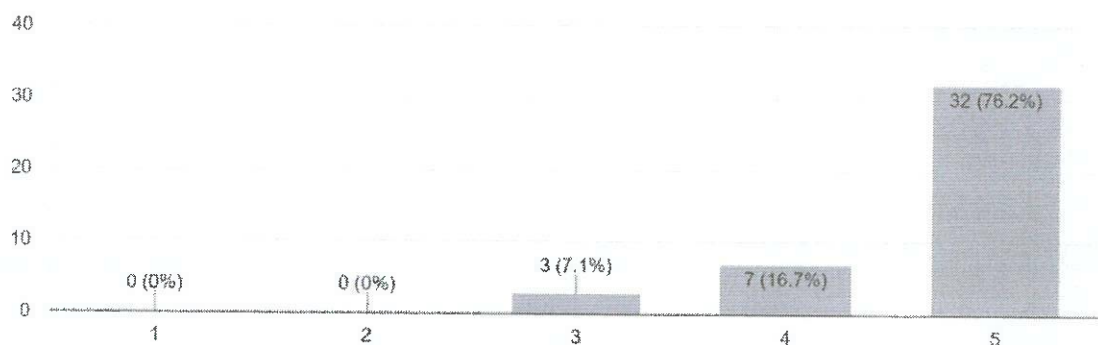

The contents of the curriculum are in tune with the UGCNET/CSIR examinations.

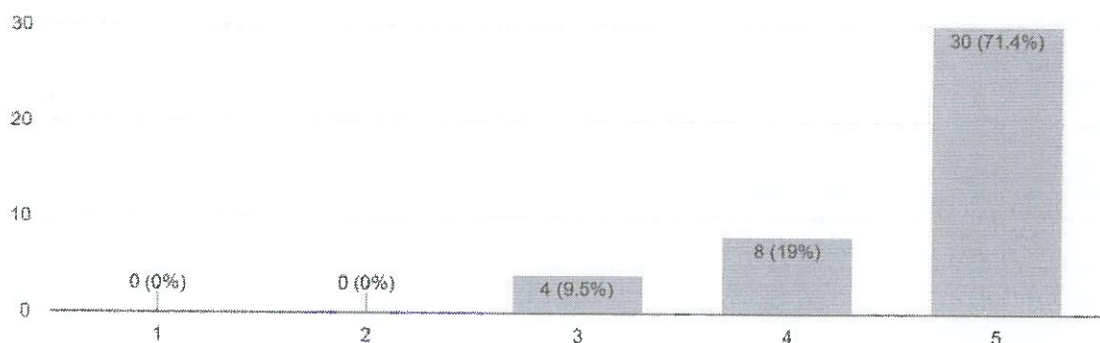

The curriculum has the potential in developing the habit of self-learning among the students.

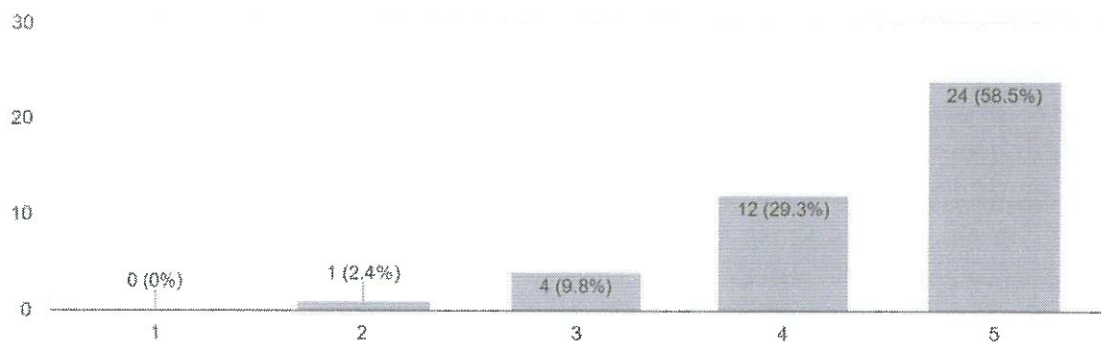

The curriculum has focus on skill development.

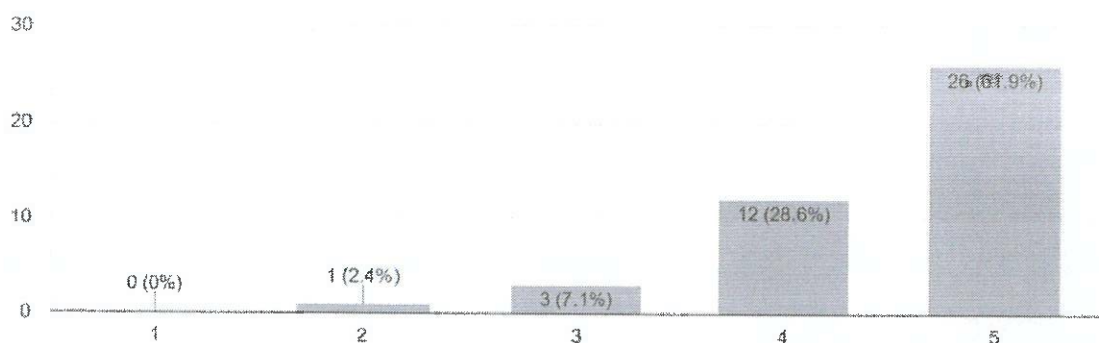

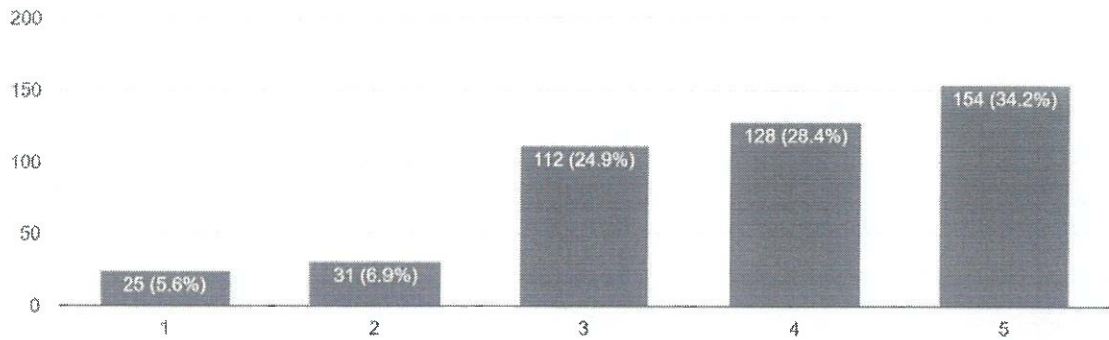

How would you rate the courses studied by you in terms of its relevance?

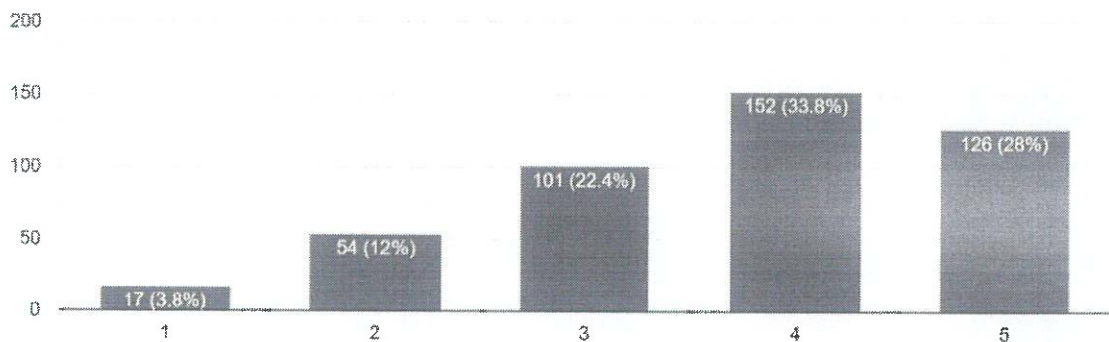

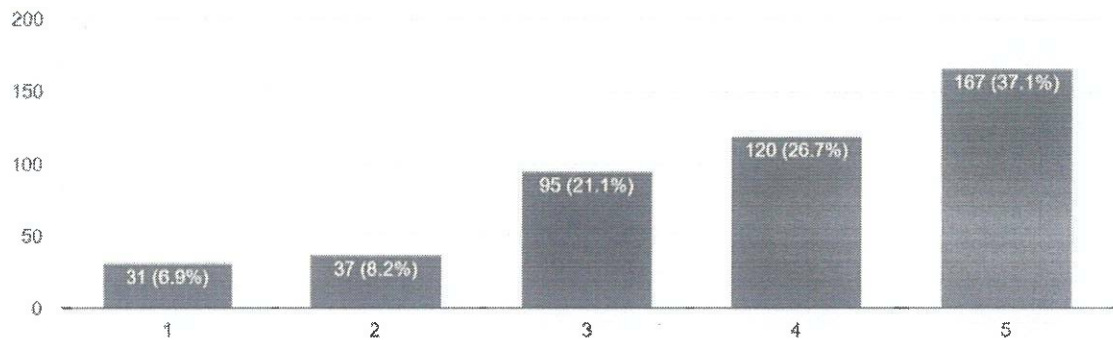

Is the entire syllabus completed in time?

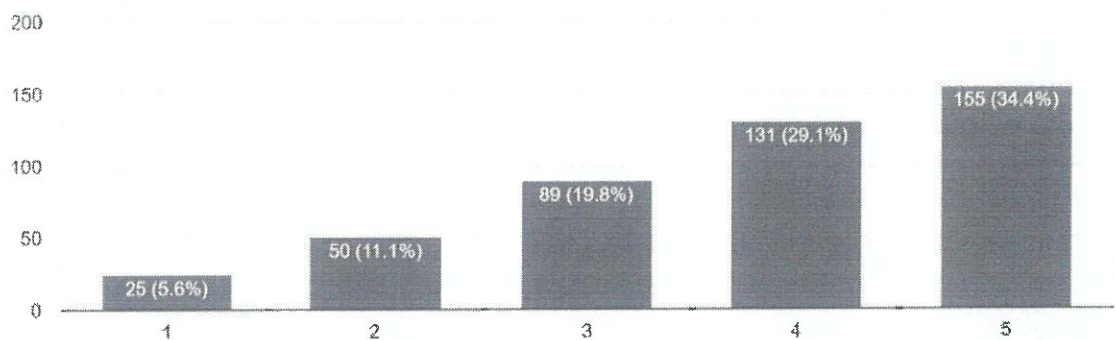

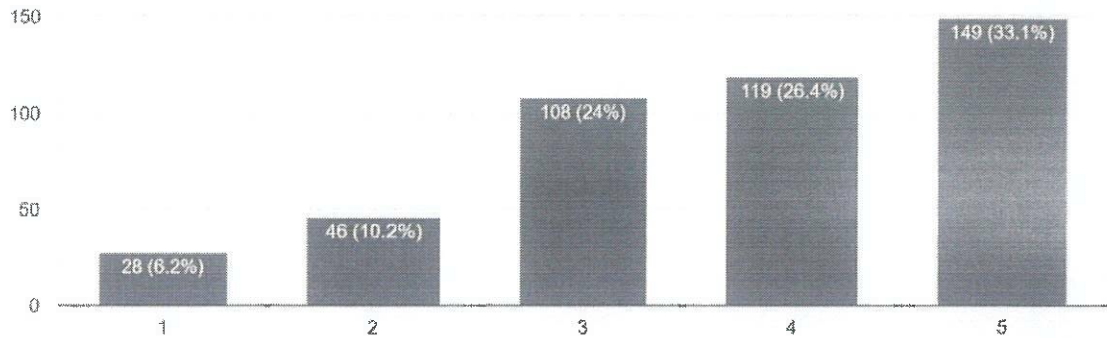

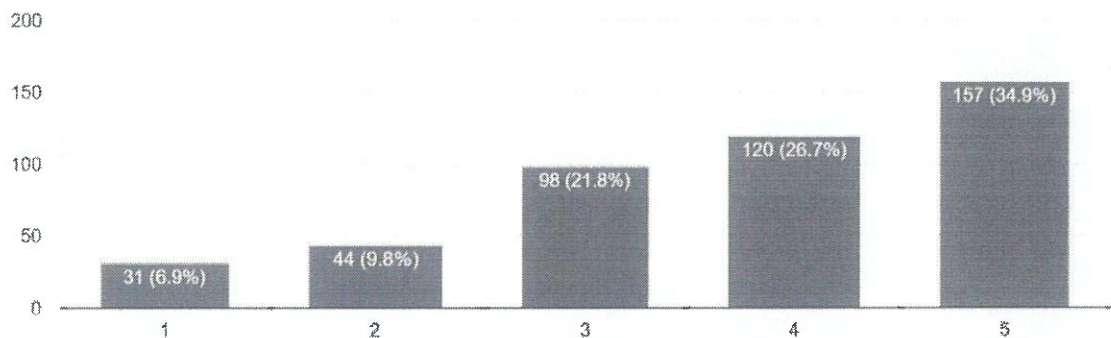

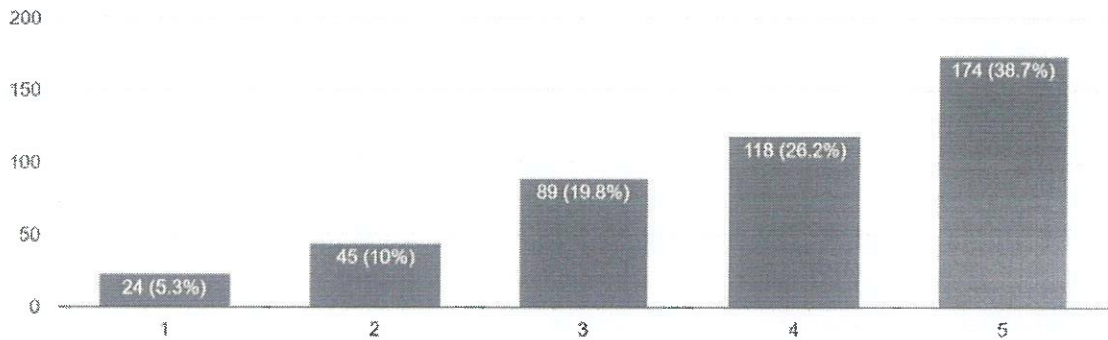

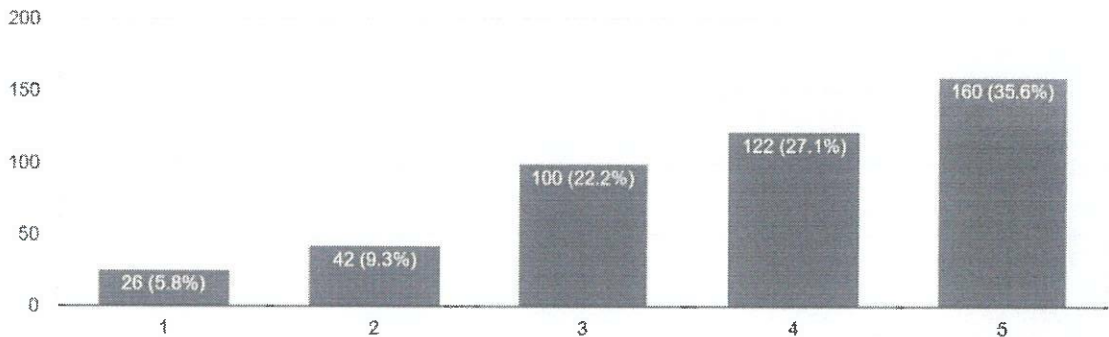

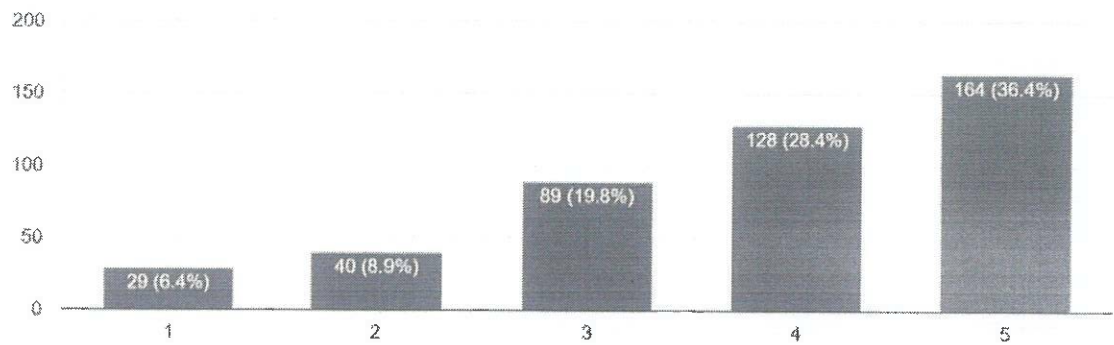

How would you rate the organisation of the Course?

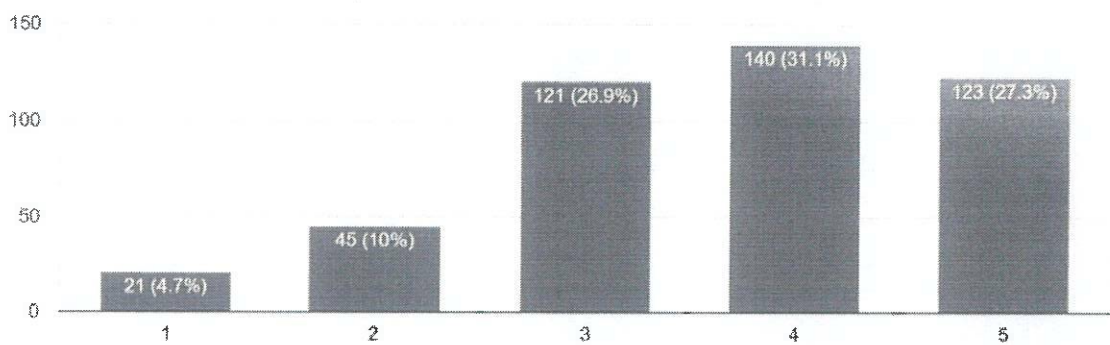

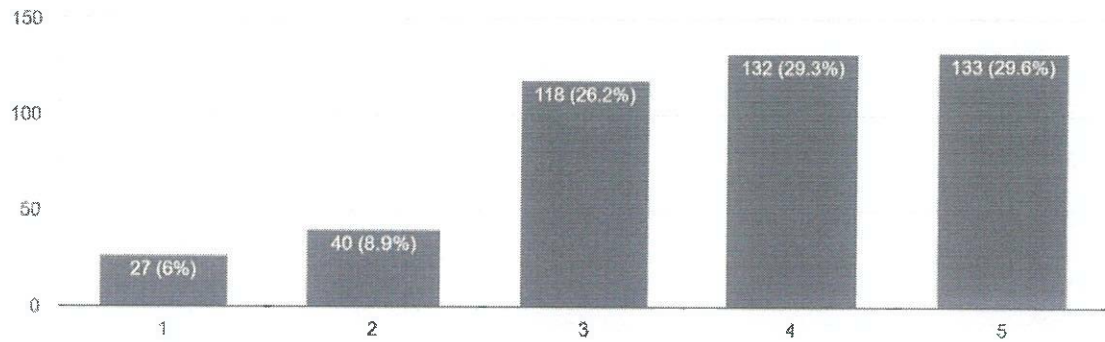

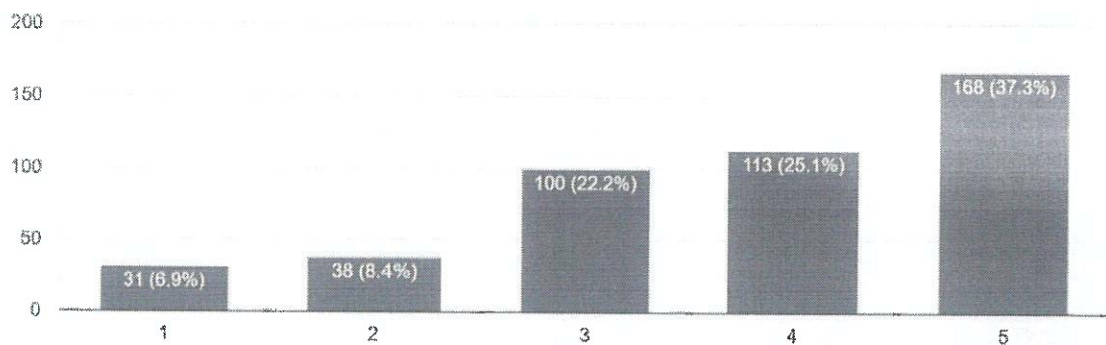

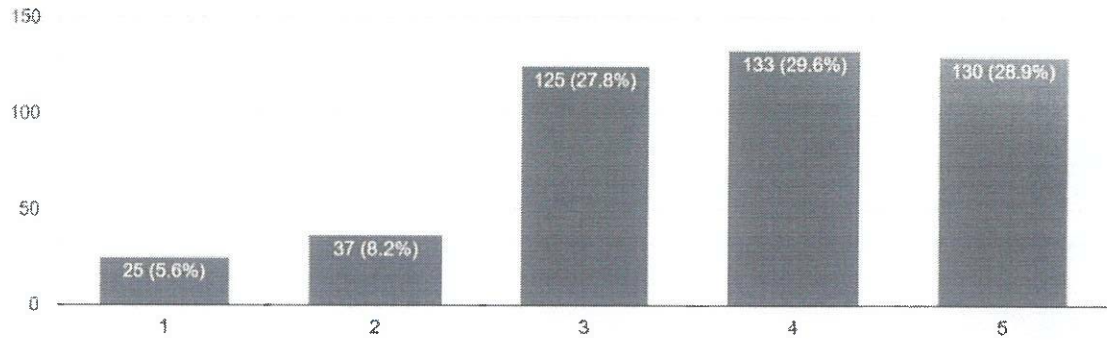

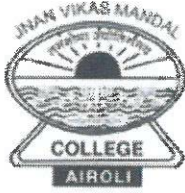

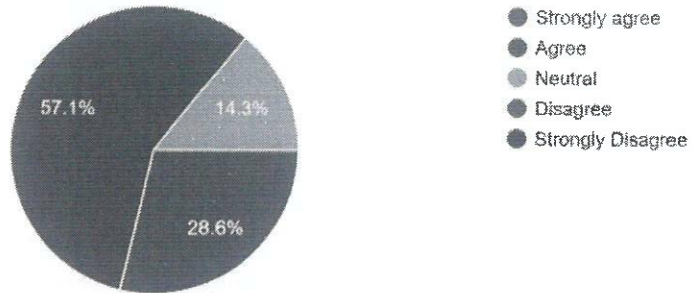
28.6% of the employers strongly agree, 42.9% of the employers agree and 28.6 % Neutral to that the curriculum taught is relevant to employ ability.

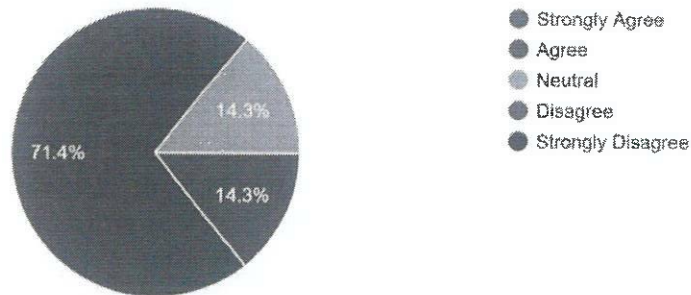


28.6% of the employers strongly agree, 57.1% of the employers agree and only 14.3% employers showed a neutral response to the question..

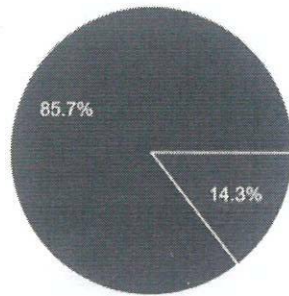

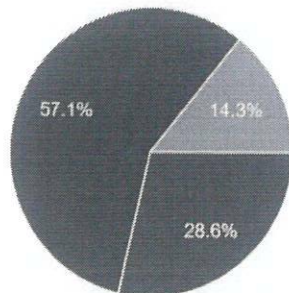

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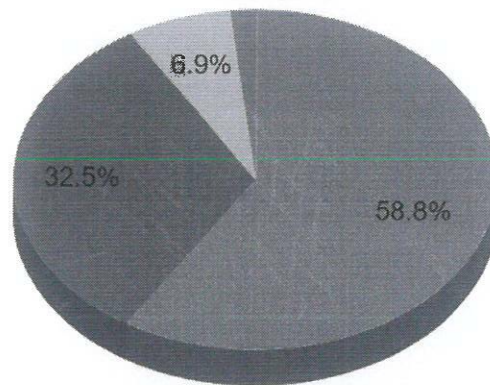

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## Alumni Feedback Analysis on Curriculum 2022-23

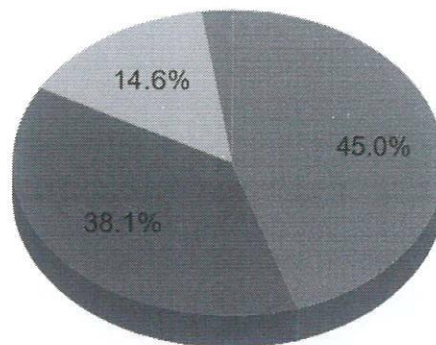
### Q.1 The Quality of teaching and learning

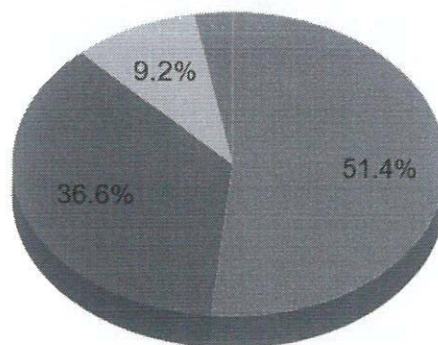


## Q.2. Role of Institution in the holistic development of the student

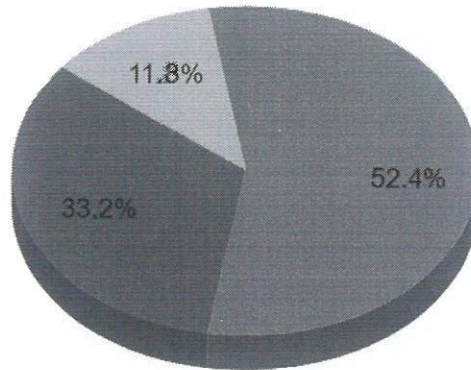
## Q.3. Encouragement for further studies

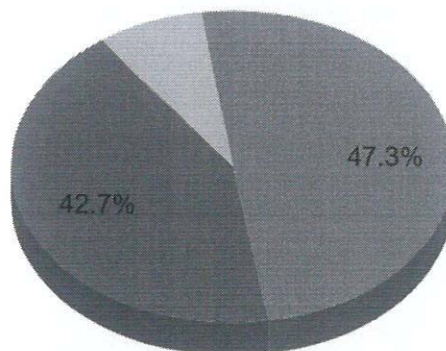


**Q.4. Role of institution in making the learner a responsible citizen of the country**

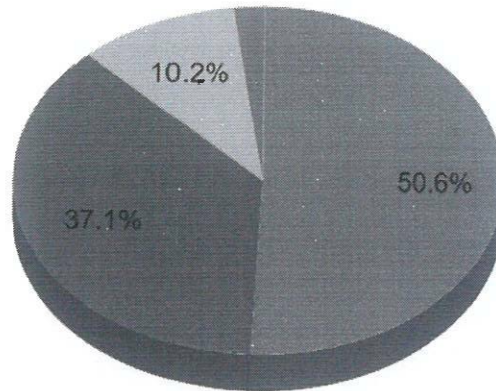
**Q.5. The name, fame and reputation of the institution in the eyes of general public**

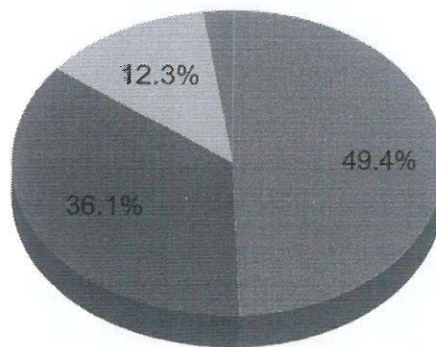


**Q.6. Development of leadership quality among the student**

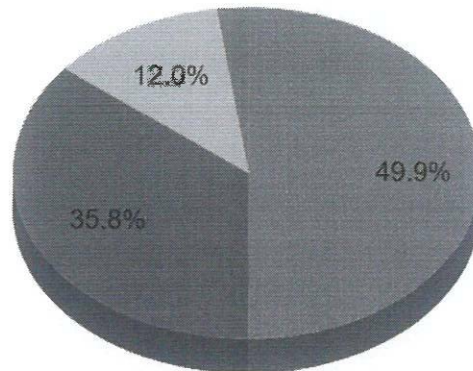
**Q.7. Creation of entrepreneurial quality among the learners.**

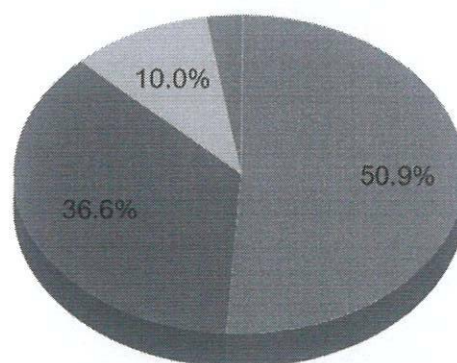


**Q.8. Role of institution in preparing the learners for competitive examination**

**Q.9. Grooming the learners in making them successful professionals**

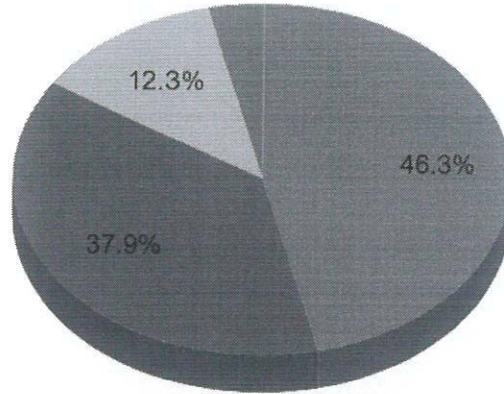
